How to be well prepared for doing the Reflective Portfolio Assignment

- 1. Do the learning cards that you were sent after each workshop as soon as you receive them (they are designed to only take 5-10 minutes of your time);
- 2. Use the SEFCE Teaching Log to record all the teaching that you do;
- 3. Get your students/trainees to complete evaluation forms at the end of your teaching sessions (standard forms, traffic light evaluations or 1 minute papers);
- 4. Have your teaching observation and feedback session with one of the Clinical Educator Programme tutors BEFORE you start writing up your portfolio.
