#### WHO can apply?

- ★ Junior doctors (FY2 doctors, core trainees, specialty trainees, registrars)
- ★ Specialty doctors
- ★ From across ALL specialties

#### What would your ROLE be?

- ★ You will have 6 medical students to tutor at any one time
- ★ You will continue with the students from year 3 – 5
- ★ Providing guidance, support and mentoring to your students
- ★ Assessing students' Portfolio case reports
- ★ Teaching your students (depending on what your students need this may involve a mixture of one-to-one teaching, small group teaching, bedside teaching, supervising clinical skills, creating mock OSCEs etc)
- ★ On average, each student should expect *30 minutes* of teaching per month but this depends on your commitments (there will be times of the year when you can give more/less teaching)
